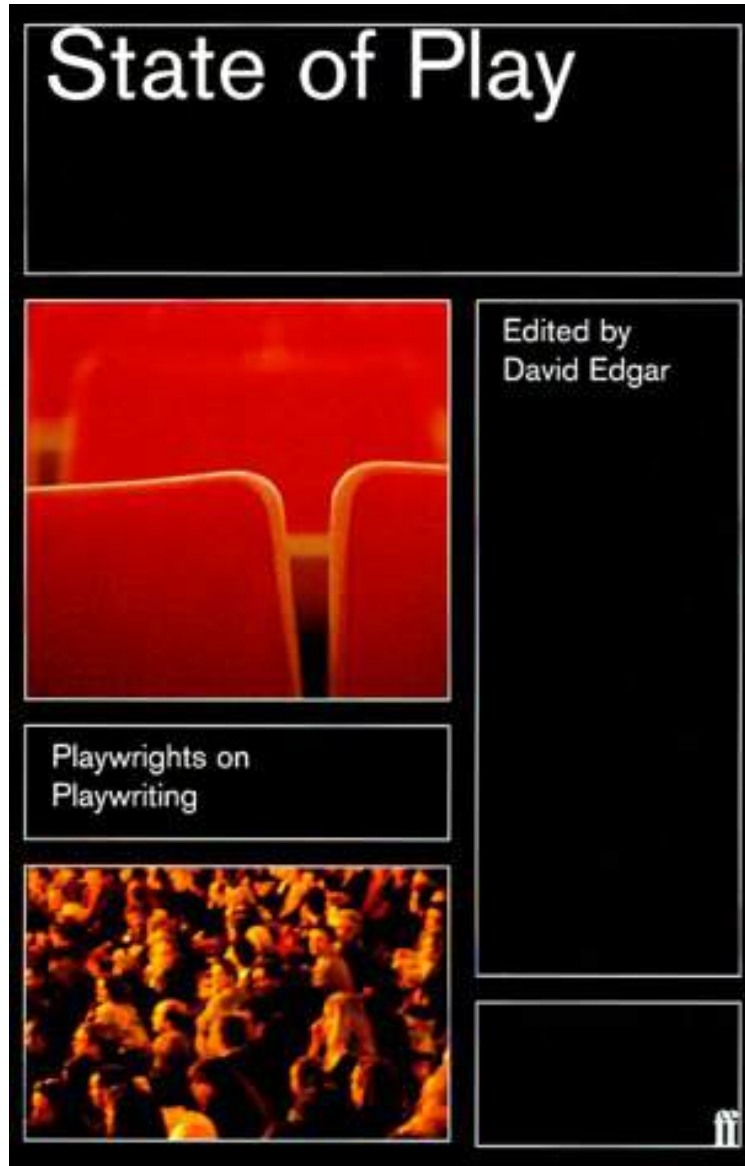


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State of Play: Playwrights on Playwriting (No.1)
